Youth Job Connection program offers a range of services and opportunities for young people to learn about jobs and gain experience working so that they may eventually secure long-term employment and meaningful careers.

Youth Job Connection program consists of:

- 2 weeks **paid** pre-employment training
- Work placement after completing the 2 weeks pre-employment

To be eligible, you must:

- Be between 15 to 29 years old at time of registration
- Be legally excused from attending high school if you are 15 to 18 years old
- Be eligible to work in Canada: Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents or Conventional Refugees
- Be a resident of Ontario
- Not be currently in full time training or education
- Be unemployed

- SIN card/letter
- Photo Identification
- Banking Information
