

SNAP® BACK

Tropicana Community Services' SNAP® BACK (Stop Now and Plan for Black, African & Caribbean Kids) program supports Black, African, and Caribbean children, ages 6–11 struggling with behavioural issues, emotional regulation, self-control, and problem-solving. The program also assists parents with strategies to support and build stronger relationships with their children.

Tropicana works with each family to assess challenges and develop action plans to prevent future anti-social behaviour and reduce the chances of conflict.
